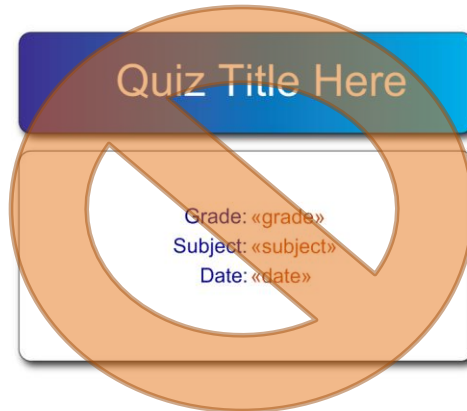


Question-by-Question Assessments in Smart Response

When using the Smart Response clickers there may be many times when you want to stop after each question, or maybe you are not interested to save any data for later.

To deliver a question-by-question assessment, be sure your question set does **NOT** have a title page. Title pages look like this:



Assessment without a Title Page

If you choose to leave off the title page in Smart Response, your assessment will run according to the following bullet points:

- It will **ONLY** allow students to see and answer one question at a time.
- You must stop and start **EACH QUESTION** rather than the full quiz.
- Data from your questions **WILL NOT** end up in the Teacher Tools database. If you wish to retain this data, you will want to export to a CSV file (addressed in the Results section)

Question-by-question quizzes are very useful if you want to work together as a whole class and you don't want students to be able to answer questions they haven't seen yet. (In elementary, it is often helpful to run Response assessments without a title slide because it keeps kids from accidentally answering without thinking about the question).

When you stop each question, you will be able to see student results and scroll under the bar or pie graph to see how each individual student answered.
